Collective worship lasts no longer than 20 minutes. During this Friday collective worship we will be giving one certificate out to each year group. We are not able to inform parents beforehand if their child is getting a certificate as we do not have the capacity to do this in advance. We will be rewarding the children for excellent listening coming into, during and go out of collective worship each day and we ask any parents attending worship to please model good listening to the children during this time. Whilst the music is playing we expect the children to enter/exit quietly and calmly and use the listening time to reflect on the message from the session.

It is with sadness that I write to tell you that Jo Roberts will leaving us on I2th January to take up a new post at West Wycombe School. Over four years Mrs Roberts has worked in the office at Radnage and been a valuable member of the staff team. An advert was placed before Christmas and we have had several potential candidates. I am pleased to be able to give you an update on the wrap around care for school. We have been working with a partner company to analyse the results of the survey that was sent out. Yesterday, staff participated in an inset training day on safeguarding and child protection. We looked at various aspects of keeping children safe in school and how we can support children who may be experiencing difficulties.
