Mrs Roberts is in the office from 8am – 3pm on Monday and Tuesday and from 8.30 – 1pm on Thursday and Friday.

Mrs Baird is the SENDco and her special needs days are Monday and Tuesday.

We have an open door policy and invite parents into school on a regular basis. If you have any concerns about your child please contact the class teacher for a mutually agreeable time to meet. I am also available to talk through any issues.

Children can be dropped off on Monday to Thursday at 8.30am for Wake & Shake – 15 minutes of fun games either in the Hall or weather permitting outside on the field. There is no limit to numbers and no need to book a place. Classrooms are open from 8.45 each morning. This allows the children to come into school calmly, work on a class challenge with a friend or have feedback from the teacher on a piece of work. All children must be in the classroom for 8.57am in time for registration. There will be a late book and I will be keeping an eye open for persistent late-comers!

Medication and Sickness

If your child is on regular medication, please see me as a health plan form must be completed. Otters, Hedgehogs, Kestrels, Kites, Falcons are on-going. If prescribed medicine is necessary during the day, a parental permission slip must be filled in. Non prescriptive will not be given by members of staff.

Please could you ensure that your contact details are up to date in case we need to contact you during the day. If your child is unwell please inform the school and if your child has been sick then at least 24 hours must pass before returning to school.

Nut allergies – we have a nut free zone in school as 5 children have serious allergies.

Holidays

Holidays in term time are only granted under special circumstances, (we are still awaiting a Government update on this). All requests should be put in writing to the Chair of Governors. Requests may be turned down. If a holiday is taken then unauthorised absence will be marked on the registers.

We had outstanding attendance last year of 97.8% and I would like to think that we can repeat 50% of the school having 100% or 99% attendance.

One of the issues that will re-occur in the newsletters is parking. We will be resending our parking policy as to where to park. Please help Mrs Roberts and myself from getting abusive phone calls re parking.

In the parental questionnaire it was mentioned that the newsletters were too 'nagging'. I will try to keep them more friendly and informative but please check the website for information before ringing the school.

Naming of school uniform – please ensure that all PE kits and sweatshirts are named. A lost property box will put out at the front of the school on a regular basis.

As our cloakroom areas are small, there is no room for large bags. These are becoming a Health & Safety hazard. A PE bag and a book bag/folder that will fit a classroom tray is all that is required.
