## Head Teacher's News

This week, I have thoroughly enjoyed immersing myself in the wonderful learning that has been taking place in all of the classrooms.

In Badgers they have been reading the Enormous Turnip. I saw some excellent writing, counting and, on Wednesday, they made (and rapidly consumed) some absolutely delicious vegetable soup.

Otters and Hedgehogs continued their English lessons based on Funny Bones and, this week, began writing their own versions. I was very impressed by their use of adjectives and how cleverly they constructed their own sentences.

Key Stage 2 have been working hard on their Maths this week; Kites and Kestrels have been exploring the number system, including negative numbers. The level of challenge in the problems they were solving was very high, but the children were impressively strategic and worked their way through to success.

Falcons and Eagles have been using stations for some Maths lessons, and it was great to see such high levels of engagement from the children as they tackled Roman Numerals. Seeing the class using a wide range of resources (including tablets, whiteboards, interactive software) to access their learning was very encouraging.

We have had many parents (and children) visit us for tours of the school already this term ready for next year's Reception intake. We have a 'stay and play' tour on the 8<sup>th</sup> November, when children can experience some time in Reception to get a feel for things, and it is already nearly full.
