This week in Collective Worship, we have been focussing on our value for this half term – forgiveness. We have been talking about the importance of second chances and how we, as a community, can support one another when we make mistakes. 'Getting it wrong' is such a vital part of the learning process, whether it is in learning or social interactions, and children need to know that they are in an environment where it is safe to make mistakes from which they can learn.

We have also had an opportunity to experience the full diversity that our curriculum offers this week. Badgers produced a delicious smelling apple crumble made from apples picked from our own tree whilst Otters and Hedgehogs have been using Funny Bones as a stimulus for their learning and showed their creativity with the full-sized model skeletons they created outside and their recital of the Funny Bones story. In Key Stage 2, Kites and Kestrels learned about the gruesome process of mummification whilst Falcons and Eagles started to experience augmented reality on the tablets by exploring their way up Mount Everest.
